- Full Time Water Distribution Operator position is an in-training position requiring general supervision with the ability to advance based on Indiana State Licenses.
- This position will be paid based on experience within the water distribution field. Pay will be in the range of 21-27 dollars per hour.
 - Ability to obtain a Distribution System Large License (DSL) issued by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management within two (2) years of employment. Ability to obtain a Class A CDL within two (2) years of employment.

Job Requirements:

- The position requires possession of a valid state driver's license and will include a personal BTC Water Truck to be used during work hours.
- The position will require the ability to respond to emergency calls and emergency duties during non-working hours including weekends and holidays.
- Under general supervision, performs a wide variety of skilled, semi-skilled duties in the installation, repair, and maintenance of systems used in the operation of the district's water distribution/treatment system; and performs related work as assigned.
- Will be required to operate and maintain a range of construction equipment, including a variety of power and hand tools.
- Maintains shop, storage sites, equipment, tools, vehicles, and other work areas or equipment in a clean and orderly condition.
